Michael Phelps (born June 30, 1985) is an American swimmer. He has won the most Olympic medals in history. He has eighteen gold medals. In the year 2000, he became the youngest sportsman to compete in the Olympic Games.

Phelps comes from Maryland, USA. His father, Fred, was a police officer who used to *keep fit* and go to the gym every other day. His mother, Debbie, taught Mathematics to grade 8 students. Phelps is the youngest child. He has two sisters: Whitney (born in 1978) and Hilary (born in 1980). Phelps started swimming in 1992, when he was 7.

Phelps swims every day and eats healthy food. His two books: *Beneath the Surface: My Story* (2004) and *No Limits: The Will to Succeed* (2008) are about his life. In his free time, he works with children who are interested in swimming. Sport is a very important part of his life.
